categories are based on scale (student numbers), region, and benefits. In order to make membership more affordable to associations in developing (non-high-income economy) countries, fees are based on the World Bank GNI - Atlas Method data. Fees relate to 2023.

- The IAC name and logo must be removed from all electronic materials (e.g., websites and online brochures) as soon as membership expires.
